

Name of Block: September Block of the Month

Date of Swap: September 5, 2018

Block Size: 6" finished

Fabric: Background: black on black prints or solid black
Blades: batiks

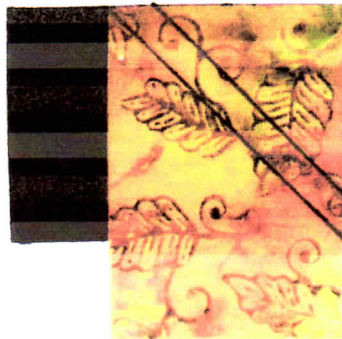
Set: one block and two triangle squares = one chance
(triangle squares can be used in a border for the quilt if desired)

Cut:

- 1) Background: cut two 3.5" x 5" rectangles
- 2) From two batiks: cut one 3.5" x 5" rectangle

Construction Instructions:

- 1) Lay one black rectangle horizontally on your work surface. Place one batik rectangle vertically, matching upper right corners. Draw a line from the corners where the fabric intersects, see diagram below (from top left corner to 3.5" down right side of rectangle). Draw a second line 1/2 away from center line.
- 2) Stitch along both lines.
- 3) Cut mid-way between the lines
- 4) Press longer piece to black fabric.
- 5) Press triangle square to black fabric
- 6) Repeat with second set of black/batik fabrics
- 7) Sew both long pieces together, with longer sides of batik fabrics to center. Press
